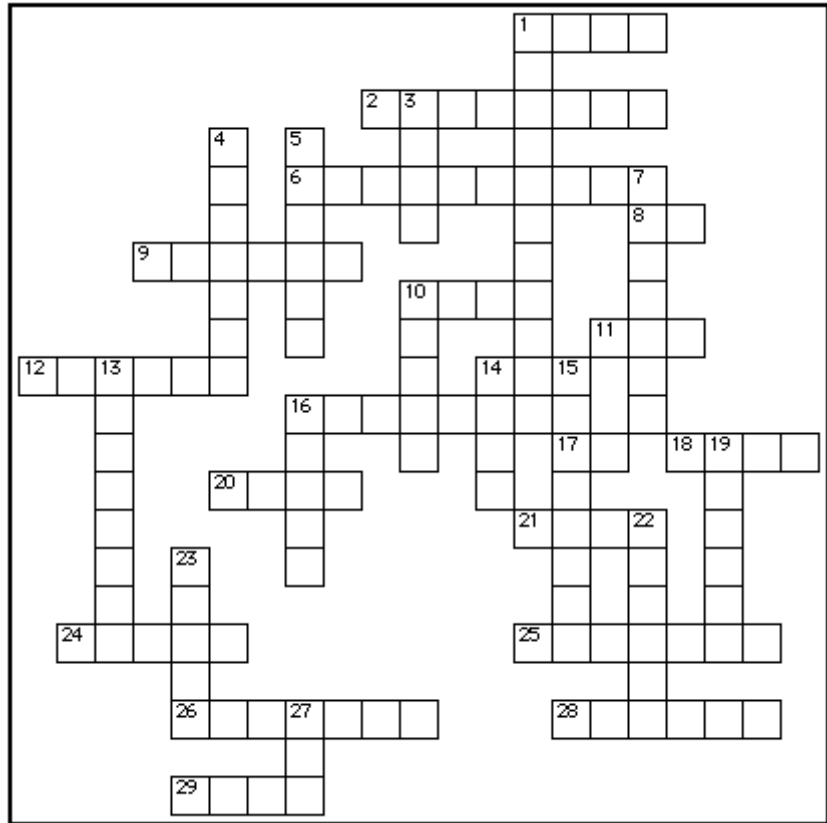


Newspaper Crossword Puzzle
