

More Healthy & Safety Teaching Ideas

- ◆ **Sport of a Lifetime:** Determine which sports mentioned in the newspaper would be the most beneficial to you as a lifetime sport. Explain why.
- ◆ **Is It Safe?** Write a letter to the editor about a safety concern. Suggest what you think should be done and who should do it.
- ◆ **Safety Bulletin Board:** Find examples of articles or columns about health or safety. Clip them for a notebook or bulletin board. Identify the 5 Ws and H (who, what, when, where, why, how) in each.
- ◆ **Food Groups:** Clip out food ads and place them under the four food groups in individual books or group charts.
- ◆ **Good & Not So Good:** Make a collage of foods that are good for you and another one for foods that are not so good for you.
- ◆ **Safety Lesson:** As part of a lesson on safety, clip 10 newspaper pictures of things that can be dangerous (scissors, knives, ropes, power tools, etc.).
- ◆ **FIRE!** Find an article about fire. Does the article describe fire as a useful agent? List three ways fire can be useful and three ways it can be destructive. Cut the article out and paste onto your paper.
- ◆ **Accidentally...** Take the newspaper and find three stories or pictures about accidents. Clip these stories/pictures out of the paper. Paste onto your paper. How could each of these accidents have been prevented?
